Covid-19 Policy and Procedures – September 2021

On 19 July 2021 the Government relaxed its Covid-19 restrictions. However, our first priority is to keep people safe, so we are keen to ensure that re-opening Cherry Garden Hall is done in a way that does not endanger users, volunteers or staff.

Southwark Council officers have carried out all the essential compliance tests to guarantee that our building is safe to use. And the TRA has completed the necessary risk assessments and set up Covid-19 procedures as advised by the council and government.

Our procedures are in accordance with the recommendations of Public Health and include:

- reduced capacity in the number allowed to use the building (maximum 30 people)
- a robust and regular cleaning regime
- the provision of hand sanitiser stations at entry and exit points
- risk assessments for all activities

Hall users are requested to comply with the following:


- keep doors and windows open to aid ventilation
- use face coverings to protect vulnerable people
- maintain social distancing where possible
- one-way systems where space permits
- if possible, use the QR code on arrival
