New fences and gates: Our TRA has replaced all the old fences and gates on the Cherry Garden Estate,



Supporting our local school: Our TRA has started giving grants to support Riverside Primary school's extracurricular activities. This summer we donated £500 towards a fun Sports Day for all the children. free-of-charge for residents. We used money we earned by letting out Cherry Garden Hall to pay for new fences and gates at Burton House, Morriss House, Cherry Garden House, Cranbourne House, Cherry Garden Street and West Lane.

Over £12,000 was spent on this project. It benefits not only the 40 ground-floor properties, but all 170 homes in these blocks. People walking through our area to the river and to Riverside School have a more pleasant view too.
